

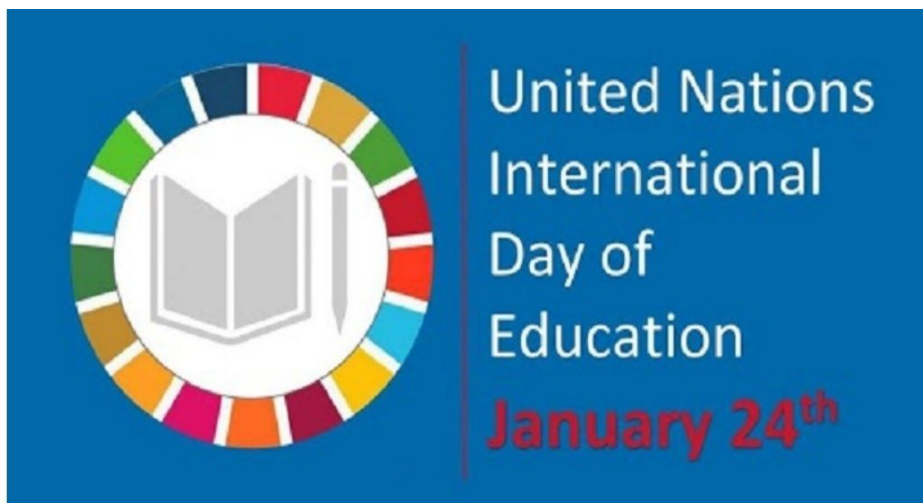

2. National Girl Child day: 24 January

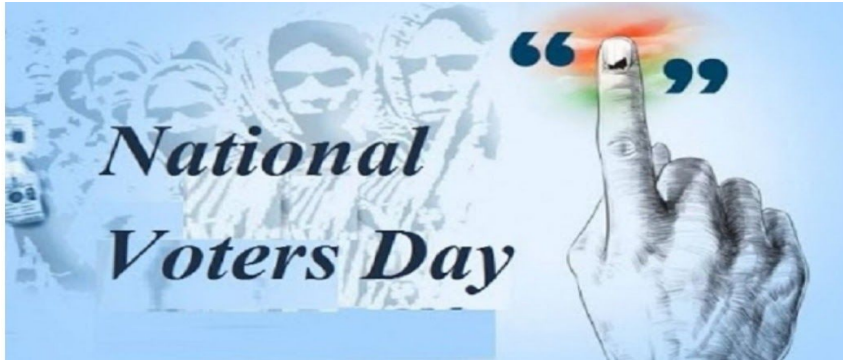


In order to eradicate the inequalities faced by girls, to promote education, health, and nutrition level of the girl child.

11th National Voters Day to encourage more young voters to take part in the political process.

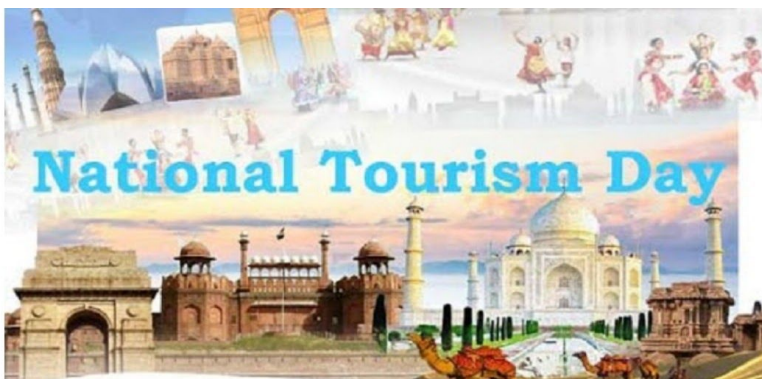
Theme-- Making Our Voters Empowered, Vigilant, Safe and Informed’.
