### France Takes Lead As First EU Nation To Offer Digital Visas

### Punjab Governor Banwarilal Purohit Resigns



Punjab Governor and Chandigarh Administrator Banwarilal Purohit resigned from his post, citing "personal reasons."

Purohit's resignation comes just a day after meeting Union Home Minister Amit Shah in

Delhi. The timing of his resignation, following the BJP's triumph in the Chandigarh mayoral polls where they secured all three posts.

Banwarilal Purohit, born on 16 April 1940, is an Indian politician who served as the 29th

Governor of Punjab, India, and Administrator of Chandigarh until 3 February 2024. He previously served as the Governor of Tamil Nadu from 2017 to 2021 and the Governor of Assam from 2016 to 2017.

### Assam Welcomes Northeast's First Naturopathy Hospital



Union Minister of Ayush and Ports, Shipping & Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, along with Chief Minister Assam, laid the foundation stone for the Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy (CRIYN) and a 100-bedded Naturopathy hospital at Dihing Khamtighat in Dibrugarh.

The institution, a pioneering force in Ayush, aims to blend traditional knowledge of Yoga and Naturopathy with modern technology. The investment of approximately ₹100 crores signifies a significant step towards promoting holistic healthcare in the region.

CRIYN is poised to set benchmark standards in education, preventive healthcare, and research in Yoga and Naturopathy. Scientific validation of traditional medicine practices will be the cornerstone, fostering evidence-based research and promoting international collaboration.

# Uttarakhand Cabinet Approves Uniform Civil Code Bill: Tabled In Assembly On Feb 6



The Uttarakhand Cabinet, led by Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami, has greenlit the Uniform Civil Code (UCC) bill, marking a historic move.

The bill, crafted based on recommendations from a government-appointed committee, will be presented in the Uttarakhand Assembly on February 6. The committee suggests banning polygamy and child marriage, advocating for uniform marriageable age and divorce procedures

If passed, Uttarakhand would be the first state post-Independence to adopt the Uniform Civil Code, aiming to standardize civil laws for all citizens, irrespective of their religious affiliations.

### Jammu And Kashmir Gets \$14 Billion From Interim Budget



India has taken a significant step towards the economic development of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir by announcing an interim Budget of \$14 billion for fiscal year 2024-25.

This financial commitment is noteworthy, as it is approximately 4.5 times greater than the total amount Pakistan is seeking from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) to address its ongoing economic challenges.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman unveiled the interim budget on a symbolic day, as Pakistan observed "Kashmir Solidarity Day." The timing of the announcement not only reflects India's resolve to prioritize the economic upliftment of Jammu and Kashmir but also serves as a message of commitment to its integral territories.

### LS Passes Finance Bill, Completes Interim Budget 2024-25



The Lok Sabha has successfully passed the Finance Bill, 2024, marking the completion of the interim budget exercise for the fiscal year 2024-25.

The interim budget does not propose any alterations to the existing tax structure, as the final budget is slated for presentation in July, post the general elections in April-May.

The Lok Sabha approved the Rs 47.66-lakh crore interim Budget 2024-25 of the Union Government. Additionally, the second batch of supplementary demands for grants was also endorsed by the House.

### RBI Grants Payment Aggregator Licences To Juspay, Zoho, And Decentro



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has recently granted final authorization to fintech firms Juspay and Decentro, along with software-as-a-service company Zoho, to operate as payment aggregators.

This approval comes in the wake of stringent criteria set by the regulator and positions these entities alongside other notable players in the payments aggregator landscape. Juspay, Decentro, and Zoho have secured the coveted payment aggregator licences from the RBI.

They join established names such as Stripe, Zomato, and Tata Pay, who received approval in January, as well as leading fintech players like Razorpay and Cashfree, which acquired the license last year

### RBI Monetary Policy, Repo Rate Holds Steady At 6.5%



The Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has made a pivotal announcement, maintaining the repo rate at 6.5 per cent.

This decision marks the sixth consecutive time the rate has remained unchanged, following closely on the heels of the Interim Budget presented on February 1, 2024.

The RBI's stance continues to focus on the withdrawal of its accommodative monetary policy, aiming to balance inflation control with economic growth. The next meeting of the MPC is scheduled during April 3 to 5, 2024.

### RBI's Analysis Report On Trend And Progress Of Banking In India 2022-23



The annual performance report of the Indian banking sector, compliant with Section 36(2) of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949, presents a comprehensive analysis of the sector's achievements and challenges.

It encompasses cooperative banks and Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs), providing insights into their contributions to the country's economic framework.

The report highlights the robustness of India's banking system and NBFCs, underpinned by high capital ratios, improved asset quality, and substantial earnings growth.

NBFCs have shown remarkable growth and improvement in asset quality, with their combined balance sheets growing by 14.8% in 2022-23.

### RBI Data Indicates 97.5% Return Of ₹2,000 Notes To Circulation



In a move that reshaped the currency landscape, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) declared the withdrawal of ₹2,000 denomination banknotes on May 19 last year.

The RBI's announcement on January 1, 2024, revealed that a staggering 97.38 per cent of ₹2,000 notes in circulation had been successfully returned.

The once ubiquitous ₹2,000 banknotes, totaling ₹3.56 lakh crore on May 19, 2023, witnessed a remarkable decline. As of January 31, 2024, the

total value shrunk to ₹8,897 crore, signifying that 97.50 percent of these notes have made their way back to the system.

#### State Govt Imposes Rs 6 Crore Fine Lakh Crore Market Cap, With TCS On Fertilizer Plant For Ammonia Leak



Forty days after an ammonia gas leak from a fertilizer plant owned by Coromandel International Limited shook Ennore in Tamil Nadu, the Environment, Climate Change and Forest Department has taken decisive actions against the company.

The leak originated from the under-sea pipeline, which was damaged during Cyclone Michaung. This underscores the need for robust infrastructure in hazardous environments.

The department has slapped a significant penalty of Rs 5.92 crore on Coromandel International Limited for its role in the gas leak incident. This reflects the seriousness with which authorities are addressing environmental hazards.

### Tata Group Achieves Historic ₹30 **Crosses 15 Lakh Crore**



Tata Group has made history by becoming the first Indian conglomerate to surpass the ₹30 lakh crore mark in combined market capitalization.

This significant achievement is driven by strong performances from key subsidiaries, including Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), Tata Motors, Tata Power, and Indian Hotels.

TCS shares reached a new peak on February 5, with a remarkable surge of over 4 percent, propelling its market capitalization beyond ₹15 lakh crore. This resurgence marks a significant milestone for the leading IT services company.

# Dharmendra Pradhan Launched EdCIL Vidyanjali Scholarship Programme




