PM Modi Launches 100,000sqm Bharat Mart In Dubai For Exports



Prime Minister Narendra Modi and UAE Vice President Mohamed bin Rashid Al Maktoum laid the foundation stone of Bharat Mart, integrating retail, warehousing, and logistics at Jebel Ali Free Trade Zone in Dubai.

The Bharat Mart facility, reminiscent of China's Dragon Mart, is a collaborative effort between DP World, a leading logistics conglomerate based in Dubai, and India's commerce ministry.

The facility, spanning over 100,000 square meters, aims to reduce shipping costs and time from India to Africa and Europe.

JAPAN COMMITS TO LONG-TERM ENGAGEMENT IN UKRAINE'S RECONSTRUCTION



As the two-year anniversary of Russia's invasion of Ukraine approaches, Japanese PM Fumio

Kishida has affirmed Japan's commitment to Ukraine's long-term reconstruction, labelling it as a strategic investment for the future.

Japan, in collaboration with the Ukrainian government and various business organizations, co-organized a conference where Kishida outlined a vision for a comprehensive partnership between the two nations.

The conference highlighted the critical role of investment across various industries for Ukraine's development, with more than 50 cooperation deals signed between Japanese and Ukrainian entities.

MALTA BECOMES 119TH COUNTRY TO JOIN INTERNATIONAL SOLAR ALLIANCE



Malta, a small yet significant player in the global arena, recently took a remarkable step towards sustainable energy by joining the International Solar Alliance (ISA).

This move underscores the country's commitment to reducing reliance on non-renewable energy sources and embracing environmentally friendly alternatives.

TURKEY'S FIRST FIFTH-GENERATION AIRCRAFT, KAAN, COMPLETES MAIDEN FLIGHT



Turkey celebrates a milestone achievement as its first fifth-generation aircraft, KAAN, successfully completes its inaugural flight, marking a significant advancement in the country's military capabilities.

On February 21, KAAN embarked on its first flight, soaring through the skies for 13 minutes and reaching an altitude of 8,000 feet, highlighting Turkish engineering and aviation expertise.

Produced by Turkish Aerospace Industries with collaboration from BAE Systems, KAAN embodies synergy between Turkish and international defense industries, leveraging technologies to deliver an air superiority fighter

INDIA-GREECE BILATERAL COOPERATION: STRENGTHENING TIES ACROSS MULTIPLE FRONTS



During a 2 day visit to India, Greek PM Kyriakos Mitsotakis engaged in extensive discussions with PM Modi to bolster cooperation between the two nations. The visit marks the first by a Greek head of state to India in 15 years.

The talks primarily focused on expanding strategic collaboration in various sectors, including trade, defense, and counter-terrorism efforts, with an emphasis on doubling bilateral trade by 2030.


CENTRE'S PROPOSAL FOR FARMERS AMIDST PROTEST: 5-YEAR MSP PLAN FOR PULSES, MAIZE, AND COTTON



A panel of Union ministers has proposed a fiveyear plan to purchase pulses, maize, and cotton at Minimum Support Prices (MSP) from farmers.

Government agencies will buy pulses, maize, and cotton crops at MSP for five years through agreements with farmers. Entities like NCCF and NAFED will enter contracts with farmers growing specific crops to ensure MSP procurement.

MAHARASHTRA GOVERNMENT EXTENDS 10% RESERVATION TO MARATHAS




The Maharashtra Cabinet has approved a draft bill to extend a 10 percent reservation to the Maratha community in both educational institutions and government employment.

The government has scheduled a special session of the state assembly to introduce the bill in response to Maratha quota activist Manoj Jarange Patil's hunger strike.

ARUNACHAL PRADESH ACHIEVES FULL HAR GHAR JAL SATURATION, FIRST IN NORTHEAST



Arunachal Pradesh has made a significant achievement by reaching 100 percent saturation in the 'Har Ghar Jal' scheme under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), announced by Chief Minister Pema Khandu.

This milestone sets Arunachal Pradesh apart as the first state in the northeast and the tenth in India to fully embrace the central government's initiative, aimed at ensuring clean and safe piped water for every household.

Launched in 2019, the JJM aims to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual household tap connections across rural India by 2024.

CHANDIGARH UNVEILS NORTH INDIA'S FIRST 'PIZZA ATM'



CITCO (Chandigarh Industrial and Tourism Development Corporation) introduces a

pizza maker near Sukhna Lake, producing hot pizzas in three minutes, a first in North India.

The pizza vending machine is the only one operational in India, marking a significant breakthrough. Dr. Rohit Shekhar Sharma, Founder & CEO at iMatrix Group of Companies leads the project inspired by France.

The machine is crafted at their Mohali factory, outperforming similar ventures, dispensing 100 pizzas daily. Operational since early 2024, the Pizza ATM swiftly becomes a local favorite, offering both vegetarian and non-vegetarian options.

1st Ever Skill India Centre Inaugurated In Sambalpur, Odisha

MADHYA PRADESH INTRODUCES 'BAG-LESS SCHOOL' INITIATIVE

The Medaram Jatara, known as Sammakka Saralamma Jatara', began this year on February 21 in Medaram, Mulugu district, showcasing Telangana's rich tribal heritage.

The Medaram Jatara holds historical significance as it commemorates the struggle of a mother and daughter duo, Sammakka and Saralamma, against unjust rulers.

India's Outward FDI In January 2024 Rises 25.7% To \$2.1 Billion



According to recent data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), In January 2024, India's outward foreign direct investment (FDI) commitments surged by 25.7% year-on-year to \$2.09 billion.

In January 2024, equity commitments surged to \$760.9 million, marking a substantial increase from \$597.4 million recorded in January 2023. However, this figure was slightly lower than the equity commitments of \$834.7 million reported in December 2023.

GOVERNMENT RAISES AUTHORIZED CAPITAL OF FCI FROM ₹10,000 CRORE TO ₹21,000 CRORE



Food Corporation of India

The government has increased the authorized capital of the Food Corporation of India (FCI) from ₹10,000 crore to ₹21,000 crore, demonstrating a significant commitment to enhancing its operational capacities.

This initiative, announced by the Food Ministry, underscores the government's dedication to strengthening FCI's role in ensuring food security and safeguarding farmers' interests.

The augmentation of authorized capital aims to bolster FCI's operational efficiency, reduce interest burdens, and positively impact government subsidies.

MORGAN STANLEY PROJECTS INDIA'S GDP GROWTH FOR FY25 TO 6.5%



In its latest analysis, Morgan Stanley Research projects India's GDP growth for FY25 to moderate to 6.5%, down from the 6.9% projected for FY24.

Despite this moderation, the report maintains a constructive outlook on the Indian economy, citing improvements in domestic demand and macro stability.

GDP growth for Q3 FY24 is expected at 6.5%, a slight slowdown from the first half of the financial year. The analysis is supported by robust services exports and declining global commodity prices, especially oil, the current account deficit is expected to remain benign...

DEFENCE NEWS

INDIAN AIR FORCE (IAF) CONDUCTED 'EXERCISE VAYU SHAKTI-24'



Indian Air Force (IAF) conducted 'Exercise Vayu Shakti-24' at the Pokhran range near Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, presenting a formidable display of its aerial firepower.

The event, attended by the Chief of Defence Staff, General Anil Chauhan, marked a significant demonstration of the IAF's offensive capabilities through a series of meticulously planned aerial manoeuvres and precision strikes.

Adhering to this year's theme, 'Lightning Strike from the Sky', the exercise involved over 120 aircraft showcasing the IAF's day and night offensive prowess.

Indian Army's Rs 57,000 Crore Project To Replace Aging T-72 Tank Fleet



The Indian Army is embarking on a significant endeavor to modernize its armored forces by replacing its aging Russian T-72 tank fleet with cutting-edge Future Ready Combat Vehicles (FRCVs).

These FRCVs, totaling 1,770 units, will be produced indigenously in India with advanced technologies including artificial intelligence (AI), drone integration, active protection systems, and enhanced situational awareness.

The induction will occur in three phases, each incorporating newer technologies for maximum survivability and lethality.

MULTINATIONAL MILITARY EXERCISE 'SHANTI PRAYAS IV' COMMENCES IN KATHMANDU



Kathmandu became the focal point of global peacekeeping efforts as it hosted the commencement of the multinational military exercise 'Shanti Prayas IV'.

This event, which draws army representatives from 19 countries actively involved in United Nations Peacekeeping missions, underscores the collaborative spirit and dedication towards maintaining global peace and security.

The Shanti Prayas Exercise is co-hosted by the Nepali Army and the U.S. Indo-Pacific Command, reflecting the strong military cooperation between Nepal and the United States

India Hosts Milan Naval Exercise With Participation Of Nearly 50 Countries



India is hosting the 12th edition of the 'Milan' naval exercise in Visakhapatnam, aimed at bolstering maritime cooperation among like-minded nations.

Navies from almost 50 countries including the US, Japan, Australia, France, Bangladesh, South Korea, Vietnam, Indonesia, and Malaysia are participating.

Milan is a biennial multinational naval exercise initiated in 1995 with the participation of Indonesia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, and Thailand, aligned with India's 'Look East' policy.

The exercise evolved under the Andaman and Nicobar Command until its 10th edition.

HAL, DRDO TO BEGIN RS 60,000 CRORE SUKHOI FIGHTER JET FLEET UPGRADE



Hindustan Aeronautics Limited in collaboration with the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) embarks on a comprehensive upgrade project worth Rs 60,000 crore for the Su-30MKI fighter jet fleet.

The initiative aims to bolster the aircraft's capabilities through the integration of advanced technologies and indigenous systems.




