PAKISTAN SUCCESSFULLY TESTS ADVANCED ROCKET SYSTEM FATAH-II



Pakistan's military successfully conducted a flight test of the indigenously developed guided multilaunch rocket system Fatah-II, showcasing a significant advancement in its missile capabilities.

With a 400-kilometer range, Fatah-II significantly expands Pakistan's strike capabilities compared to the previous Fatah-1 system (250 kilometers). This enhances strategic deterrence and provides greater operational flexibility.

The system features "state-of-the-art avionics, sophisticated navigation system, and unique flight trajectory," according to the Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR), ensuring high accuracy in hitting designated targets.

The successful test underlines Pakistan's growing self-reliance in defense technology.

Fatah-II represents the culmination of years of research and development by Pakistani scientists and engineers.

PRESIDENT DRAUPADI MURMU GIVES ASSENT TO THREE CRIMINAL CODE BILLS



On December 25, President Draupadi Murmu granted her assent to three groundbreaking criminal code bills, marking a significant shift in India's legal land-scape.

These bills, namely the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, and the Bharatiya Sakshya Act, received parliamentary approval and are poised to replace the age-old Indian Penal Code, the Code of Criminal Procedure, and the Indian Evidence Act of 1872.

The trio of bills aims to redefine various offenses and their corresponding punishments.

Notably, the legislation provides a clear definition of terrorism and introduces a novel section titled "Offences Against the State." Strikingly, it abolishes sedition as a crime, replacing it with a more contemporary framework.

GWALIOR ACHIEVES GUINNESS RECORD WITH 'LARGEST TABLA ENSEMBLE' AT TANSEN FESTIVAL

In response to the suspension of the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) by the Sports Ministry, the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) has established a three-member ad hoc committee to oversee the day-to-day operations of the WFI.

The Sports Ministry took action three days after the WFI elected new office bearers, including Sanjay Singh as president. The ministry accused the WFI of violating its own constitution and instructed the IOA to form an ad-hoc panel.

The committee is tasked with overseeing various aspects of WFI's operations, including athlete selection, international event participation, organizing sports activities, managing finances, handling the website, and other related responsibilities.

MHA DECLARES MUSLIM LEAGUE JAMMU KASHMIR (MASARAT ALAM FACTION) UNLAWFUL UNDER UAPA



The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has designated the Muslim League Jammu Kashmir (Masarat Alam faction) as an "unlawful association" for a five-year period under the anti-terror Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA).

The Ministry revealed that the outfit had been actively raising funds through various sources, including Pakistan and its proxy organizations, to perpetrate unlawful activities.

The organization's objectives included seeking the freedom of Jammu and Kashmir from India, aspiring to merge the region with Pakistan, and establish Islamic rule.

VASUDEV DEVNANI ELECTED AS THE SPEAKER OF RAJASTHAN ASSEMBLY

INCIDENT OF AMMONIA GAS LEAKAGE REPORTED IN ENNORE REGION, CHENNAI



Late on Tuesday night, a fertilizer plant in North Chennai's Ennore area experienced an ammonia gas leak, leading to the hospitalization of around 50 people.

The gas leak occurred from an underwater pipeline that runs from the sea to the fertilizer manufacturing facility of Coromandel International Limited.

The affected individuals experienced symptoms such as breathlessness, burning in their eyes, throat, nose, and chest. In the aftermath of the incident, local residents expressed anger and concern, demanding the immediate closure of the factory.

AYODHYA AIRPORT TO BE RENAMED MAHARISHI VALMIKI AIRPORT



Ayodhya, the holy city in Uttar Pradesh, is all set to get its first international airport, marking a significant development in its pilgrimage and tourism potential.

The airport currently boasts the lengthy name "Maryada Purushottam Shri Ram International Airport."

The Yogi Adityanath government is reportedly considering renaming it "Maharishi Valmiki Airport," honoring the revered poet who authored the epic Ramayana.

DISINVESTMENT SET TO MISS FY24 TARGET, RAISES OVER RS 4 TRILLION IN A DECADE



As the specter of impending general elections looms, the government's privatization endeavors have slowed, opting for caution in the face of potential accusations of selling off national assets.

The ambitious disinvestment target for the current fiscal year is likely to be missed, with major plans, including Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd (BPCL), Shipping Corporation of India (SCI), and CONCOR, pushed to the backburner. Analysts suggest that substantive privatization may only resume after the April/May elections.
