NEPAL'S KAMI RITA SHERPA SETS NEW RECORD WITH 29TH EVEREST ASCENT



Renowned Nepali mountaineer Kami Rita Sherpa has achieved a historic feat by conquering Mount Everest for the 29th time. At 54 years old, Kami reached the 8,849-meter summit at 7:25 am local time on Sunday, leading a group of climbers organized by Seven Summit Treks. His remarkable journey began in 1992, and since then, he has fearlessly conquered several of the world's highest peaks, including K2, Cho Oyu, Lhotse, and Manaslu. Kami's dedication and expertise have solidified his place in mountaineering history.

#### INDIA-OMAN COLLABORATION ON SHARK AND RAY RESEARCH IN ARABIAN SEA



In a significant move to bolster research and conservation efforts concerning sharks and rays in the Arabian Sea, India and Oman are set to embark on a joint initiative. RUSSIA'S CONTROVERSIAL OIL AND GAS DISCOVERY IN BRITISH ANTARCTIC TERRITORY



In a development that has raised eyebrows globally, Russia has claimed to have discovered massive oil and gas reserves in the British Antarctic Territory, a region currently protected under the 1959 Antarctic Treaty. According to evidence submitted to the Commons Environment Audit Committee, the reserves uncovered by Russian research ships contain around 511 billion barrels worth of oil, a staggering amount equivalent to approximately 10 times the North Sea's output over the last 50 years.



RELIANCE CAPITAL ACQUISITION: HINDUJA GROUP'S IIHL RECEIVES IRDAI APPROVAL

INDIA'S FACTORY OUTPUT AND INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS



Factory output in India saw a notable rise, registering a growth of 4.9% in March, a significant leap from the 1.9% recorded in the same period the previous year. However, this figure fell slightly short of February 2024's 5.7%. For the fiscal year 2023-24, the factory output grew by 5.8%, a marginal increase from the previous year. The uptick was particularly evident in manufacturing and construction goods output.

INDIA'S RETAIL INFLATION MARGINALLY EASES TO 4.83% IN APRIL



India's retail inflation has eased marginally to touch an 11-month low of 4.83 per cent on an annual basis in April, according to government data released on Monday. This slight dip from the previous month's figure of 4.85 per cent aligns closely with the projections of a Reuters poll of 44 economists, who estimated the number to come down to 4.80 per cent. Importantly, this figure falls within the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) tolerance band of 2-6 per cent.

INDIA'S URBAN UNEMPLOYMENT RATE DECLINES **TO 6.7% IN MARCH QUARTER** 


