IIT DHARWAD DEVELOPS FIRE RESCUE ASSISTANCE DRONE



A group of teachers and students at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Dharwad, directed by Profs. Sudheer Siddapureddy and Ameer Mulla, with funding from the TiHAN Foundation, IIT Hyderabad (NMICPS, Indian government), have created a drone for fire rescue assistance. The drone

was unveiled and demonstrated during the two-day workshop on Drone design and autonomous navigation in fire rescue (DDANFR 2024), organized by the Fire and Thermal Research Laboratory (FLRL) and the Control System and Robotics Laboratory at IIT Dharwad on May 31 and June 1.


MICRON STARTED ITS PRODUCTION IN INDIA
