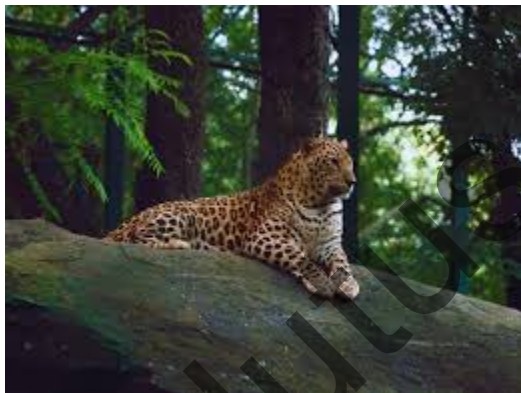
### **\*\*National:\*\***

#### **- \*\*Fast Track Immigration – Trusted Traveller Programme (FTI-TTP)\*\*:**



Inaugurated by Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah at Terminal-3 of the Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. It aims to streamline immigration clearance for Indian nationals and OCI cardholders through e-gates.

#### **- \*\*India's Largest Leopard Safari\*\*:**



Opened at Bannerghatta Biological Park near Bengaluru, covering 20 hectares and currently housing eight leopards, with plans for expansion.

#### **- \*\*Inauguration of Chadwick House\*\*:**



India's first museum dedicated to the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India, showcasing historical artifacts and the CAG's role in governance, located in Shimla.
