

GOVERNMENT INAUGURATES NATIONAL LANDSLIDE FORECASTING CENTER

REVIVED INTEREST SUBSIDY UNDER PRADHAN MANTRI AWAS YOJANA (URBAN) 2.0



The government has reinstated the interest subsidy under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) 2.0, allocating ₹4,000 crore for the Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS) and ₹30,170 crore for PMAY-U. This targets EWS, LIG, and Middle-Income Groups, aiming to construct 3 crore additional houses with a total investment of ₹10 lakh crore over five years.

NAMO DRONE DIDI SCHEME AND SUPPORT FOR NATURAL FARMING



The Finance Minister introduced the Namo Drone Didi scheme with a ₹500 crore allocation to provide drones to 15,000 women self-help groups for rental services to farmers. Additionally, the initiative supports 1 crore farmers with certification, branding, and the establishment of 10,000 bio-input resource centers.

BHU-AADHAAR: UNIQUE IDENTIFICATION FOR LAND PARCELS



The Union Budget 2024-25 plans to assign unique identification numbers, termed "Bhu-Aadhaar," to all land parcels in rural areas. This includes digitizing cadastral maps and creating a comprehensive land registry linked to farmers to streamline land administration and reduce fraud.

ALLOCATION FOR AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL FARMING



Significant funds in the Union Budget 2024-25 have been allocated for agriculture and natural farming, including ₹1.52 lakh crore for agriculture and allied sectors. The initiative also aims to support 1 crore farmers and establish 10,000 bio-input resource centers for natural farming.

URBAN DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES



The Union Budget 2024-25 highlights urban development initiatives with a ₹10 lakh crore investment for PM Awas Yojana Urban 2.0. Additionally, new strategies for transit-oriented development in large cities and the development of 100 weekly 'haats' or street food hubs each year for the next five years are included.

BIHAR PASSES ANTI-PAPER LEAK BILL TO COMBAT EXAM MALPRACTICES



On July 24, 2024, the Bihar Assembly passed the Anti-Paper Leak Bill to combat malpractices in government recruitment exams, with strict penalties including a minimum prison sentence of 10 years and a fine of at least ₹1 crore.

OTT PLATFORM HELLO MEGHALAYA



The Manns and Hajongs, two small communities in Meghalaya, will be featured on the new OTT platform Hello Meghalaya.


Celebrated to honor the inception of radio broadcasting in India in 1927.
