Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently released three books on the life and journey of M. Venkaiah Naidu on his 75th birthday. The titles of these books are "Dr. V" (a compilation of Naidu's life events and contributions), "Naidu's Memoirs" (covering his personal and professional milestones), and "Venkaiah's Vision" (detailing his thoughts and speeches).

SOUTH ASIA'S LARGEST FLYING TRAINING ORGANIZATION IN MAHARASHTRA



South Asia's largest flying training organization will be established in Maharashtra, aiming to enhance aviation training infrastructure in the region.

HUL KRANTI DIWAS



Celebrated annually on June 30, Hul Kranti Diwas commemorates the 1855 tribal independence movement against British rule, led by Sidhu, Kanho, Chand, and Bhairav. Over 50,000 tribals from 400 Jharkhand villages participated in this revolt.

INDIA PREPARES COMPLETE LIST OF FAUNA



India recently became the first country to prepare a complete list of its fauna, documenting the diverse wildlife found across the nation.

NEW SPECIES OF FROG DISCOVERED IN ARUNACHAL PRADESH



Researchers from the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) have discovered a new species of forest-dwelling horned frog in Arunachal Pradesh. Named *Xenophrys apatani*, it was found in Talle Wildlife Sanctuary and is named after the Apatani community for their efforts in wildlife conservation.

INAUGURATION OF NEW FILING COUNTER IN SUPREME COURT



Chief Justice of India (CJI) DY Chandrachud inaugurated a new filing counter in the Supreme Court, aimed at improving administrative efficiency and accessibility for legal filings.

HAJ COMMITTEE NOW UNDER MINORITY AFFAIRS MINISTRY



The government has transferred the responsibility of the Haj Committee to the Ministry of Minority Affairs, which was previously managed by the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA). This change includes new regulations and the appointment of officers from various ministries to the committee.

RAJASTHAN'S TEN-YEAR ROAD SAFETY PLAN



Rajasthan will be the first state in India to create a ten-year action plan to improve road safety. This plan aims to reduce traffic accidents by 50% by 2030 and is supported by Deputy Chief Minister Prem Chand Bairwa.

PRIME MINISTER MODI RECEIVES RUSSIAN HONOR



Prime Minister Narendra Modi was presented with the Order of St Andrew the Apostle the First-Called at the Moscow Kremlin. This honor recognizes his efforts in strengthening the partnership between Russia and India.

THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MANDATES BIS STANDARDS FOR ALL STAINLESS STEEL AND ALUMINUM UTENSILS



The Government of India has mandated that all stainless steel and aluminum utensils conform to the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS). This directive, effective from March 14, 2024, under the Quality Control Order issued by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, makes the ISI mark compulsory for these utensils.

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA MODI INAUGURATES INS TOWERS IN MUMBAI



Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the INS Towers at the Indian Newspaper Society (INS) Secretariat in Mumbai's Bandra Kurla Complex. This new facility serves as a modern hub for the newspaper industry, addressing the evolving needs of INS members. The inauguration underscores efforts to bolster infrastructure supporting India's media sector

UGC'S ASMITA PROJECT: 22,000 INDIAN LANGUAGE BOOKS TO TRANSFORM HIGHER EDUCATION



The Ministry of Education and the University Grants Commission (UGC) have launched ASMITA (Augmenting Study Materials in Indian Languages through Translation and Academic Writing), aiming to develop 22,000 books in Indian languages over the next five years

FOUNDATION OF INDIA'S LONGEST URBAN TUNNEL PROJECT



Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently laid the foundation for India's longest urban tunnel project in Maharashtra. This tunnel aims to alleviate traffic congestion and improve connectivity in the urban area, significantly boosting the region's infrastructure and economic development.

Ajay Kumar Sood, the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, recently launched the report on the e-mobility R&D roadmap for India. This report outlines strategic research and development initiatives to accelerate the adoption of electric mobility solutions in the country.

INDIA LAUNCHES FIRST NATIONAL TOLL-FREE ANTI-NARCOTICS HELPLINE



India is set to launch its first national toll-free anti-narcotics helpline, '1933', alongside an email service under the name MANAS (Madak Padarth Nisedh Asuchna Kendra).
