4. Commemorative Stamps for Paris Olympics



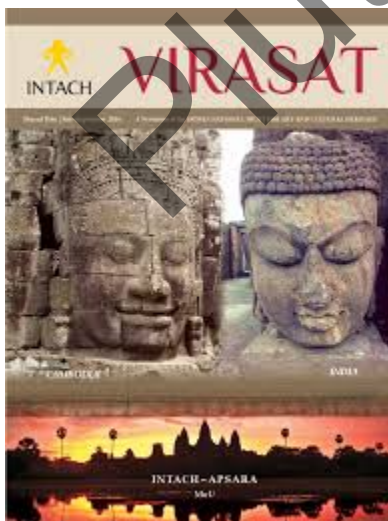
Union Ministers Jyotiraditya Scindia and Mansukh Mandaviya will release commemorative stamps on August 5th to honor the Paris Olympics.
