1. Third Edition of 'Har Ghar Tiranga' Campaign



- The third edition of the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign is being held from August 9 to August 15, 2024. This initiative encourages citizens to display the national flag at their homes to foster patriotism and national pride. The campaign has received significant public support in the past, with Prime Minister Narendra Modi urging citizens to continue this tradition.

2. India Wins Gold at 4th CAVA Women's Volleyball Nations League



- The Indian women's national volleyball team won the gold medal at the 4th Central Asian Volleyball Association (CAVA) Women's Volleyball Nations League. 
7. Neeraj Chopra Wins Silver in Javelin at Paris 2024 Olympics
