 The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has introduced stricter regulations for Housing Finance Companies (HFCs)

• The international investment arm of Bharti Enterprises, is set to acquire a 24.5% stake in the British telecom giant BT Group plc for approximately \$4 billion. This investment signifies a major expansion of Bharti's global telecom ambitions and is expected to enhance India-UK bilateral relations. The move is part of a strategic effort by Indian companies to strengthen their presence in foreign markets.

Economy News

India's retail inflation rate, as measured by the Consumer Price Index (CPI), fell to 3.5% in July, reaching a nearly 5-year low.



This decline is attributed to a high base effect and a significant drop in food prices. The inflation rate has dipped below the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI's) medium-term target of 4% for the first time since August 2019, which may encourage the RBI to maintain its current policy stance.

An annual bilateral engagement between the Indian Army and the Sri Lankan Army, commenced on August 12, 2024, at the Sri Lankan Army Training School in Maduru Oya.
