

Current Affairs: 06 September, 2024 National:

1. Assam to Celebrate "Sootea Day":



Starting from 2025, Assam will observe August 20 as "Sootea Day" to honor the region's role in India's freedom struggle. This marks the 1942 event when locals hoisted the national flag at Sootea Police Station during the Quit India Movement. A heritage monument will be built at the site with a ₹5 crore budget.

2. Kerala Tops BRAP and SRAP Rankings:



Kerala secured the top spot in the Business Reforms Action Plan (BRAP) and State Reform Action Plan (SRAP) by excelling in nine reform categories. The rankings were released by the Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry, recognizing Kerala's efforts to improve business and citizen-centric services.

3. First International Solar Festival in Delhi:



The first International Solar Festival was held in Delhi on September 5-6, 2024, promoting solar power as a sustainable energy source. Addressed virtually by PM Modi, the event highlighted India's solar energy achievements and saw participation from over 100 countries.

4. PM Modi Launches 'Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari' Initiative:
