1. **PM Modi Launches Namo Bharat Rapid Rail and New Vande Bharat Trains**



- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the Namo Bharat Rapid Rail between Ahmedabad and Bhuj. The train, also known as Vande Metro, covers 360 km in 5 hours and 45 minutes. Several other Vande Bharat trains were launched on new routes.

2. **Angkor Wat Named Most Photogenic UNESCO World Heritage Site in Asia**
