

1. **Union Cabinet Approves Simultaneous Elections (One Nation, One Election)*



- The Union Cabinet accepted recommendations for conducting simultaneous elections across the country.

- This initiative, chaired by former President Shri Ram Nath Kovind, aims to streamline electoral processes and reduce expenses.

2. **Chandrayaan-4 Mission Approved*



- The Union Cabinet has approved a new moon mission, Chandrayaan-4, focused on returning to Earth with Junar samples.

- The mission will involve advanced space technologies, with a budget of ₹2,104.06 crore and a completion time of 36 months.

3. **India to Build Its Own Space Station by 2028**



- The Union Cabinet has approved the first module of the Bharatiya Antriksh Station (BAS) as part of the Gaganyaan program.

- It will boost India's space research and capabilities in human spaceflight.



4. **India Becomes the 6th Largest Market in MSCI ACWI**

- India surpassed China to become the 6th largest market in the MSCI All Country World Investable Market Index.

- India's current weight in the index is 2.35%, narrowly behind France.



5. **Cabinet Clears Major Subsidy Proposals**

- A ₹24,474.53 crore subsidy for fertilizers during the rabi season and an updated PM-AASHA scheme with a budget of ₹35,000 crore were approved to support agriculture.
