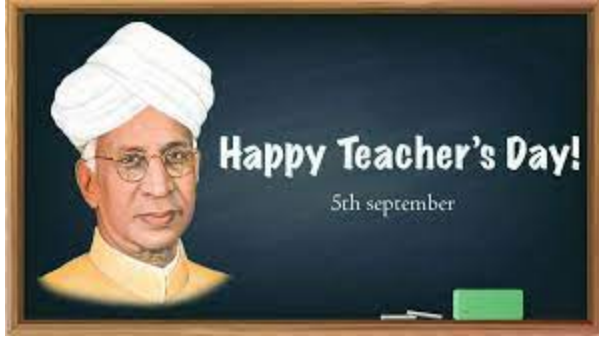
6. Brendon McCullum Appointed as England's Head Coach:
