1. **Marburg Virus Outbreak in Rwanda**



Recently, six people have died due to a Marburg virus outbreak in Rwanda. Marburg Virus Disease (MVD) is a rare but severe hemorrhagic fever that affects humans and primates, caused by the Marburg virus, similar to Ebola. The virus was first identified in 1967 in Marburg, Germany, linked to infected green monkeys, and its primary host is the African fruit bat.

2. **PM Modi's Visit to Solar Panels under PM Muft Bijli Solar Yojana**



Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently visited solar panels installed under the PM Muft Bijli Solar Yojana in Gujarat.
