National News

1. **16th Century Copper Plates Discovered**:



A significant archaeological discovery was made at the Sri Singeeswarar temple in Mappedu village, Tiruvallur district, where a set of 16th-century copper plates was found. The inscriptions on these plates are written in Sanskrit using the Nandinagari script and were created in 1513 during the reign of King Krishnadevaraya.

2. **Hurricane Oscar Hits Cuba**



Hurricane Oscar made landfall in the Bahamas and crossed the eastern coast of Cuba, resulting in at least six fatalities. The storm caused widespread destruction and triggered protests as power outages disrupted daily life.
