1. **India's ICAR-NRC Equine Receives WOAH Reference Laboratory Status**



The Indian Council of Agricultural Research-National Research Centre on Equines (ICAR-NRC Equine) has been designated as a **World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) Reference Laboratory** for Equine Piroplasmosis. This accreditation underscores India's growing leadership in animal health and diagnostics.

2. **Ricky Kej and Anoushka Shankar Nominated for Grammy Awards**



Indian musicians **Ricky Kej** and **Anoushka Shankar** received Grammy nominations for the **67th Grammy Awards**. Kej earned a nomination for his album *Break of Dawn* in the Best New Age, Ambient, or Chant Album category. Shankar's album *Chapter II: How Dark It Is Before Dawn* was also nominated in the same category.

3. **IIT Delhi's Global Rank in QS World University Rankings**
