1. **Dolphin Ambulance by NMCG**

- It reflects a strong recovery in global trade and domestic manufacturing.



10. **Birsa Munda Jayanti**




- November 15 is celebrated as Birsa Munda Jayanti to honor the tribal freedom fighter.
