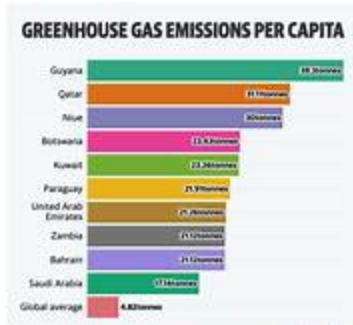
2. **PM Modi Inaugurates 1st Bodoland Mahotsav**
