6. Global Cooperative Conference 2024



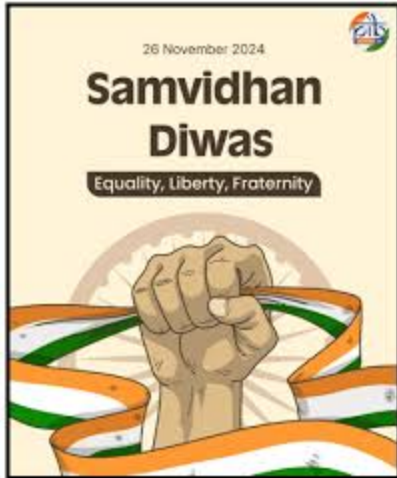
Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the Global Cooperative Conference in New Delhi, marking the UN's International Year of Cooperatives 2025.
