1. - **Gabon Approves New Constitution**:

Odisha won its first-ever gold medal in the 14th Senior National Hockey Championship.


11. - **Magnus Carlsen Wins Tata Steel Chess India Blitz Title**:

12. - **Rani Lakshmibai's Birth Anniversary**:




India celebrated the birth anniversary of Rani Lakshmibai, a symbol of courage and patriotism.
