1. **October GST Collection Grows by 8.9%, Totals ₹1.87 Trillion**



The gross GST collection in October 2024 registered an 8.9% increase, reaching ₹1.87 trillion. This growth is largely attributed to improvements in domestic transactions, while revenue from imports saw slower growth.

2. **UPI Transactions Hit Record ₹23.5 Trillion in October**



India saw a record increase in digital transactions in October 2024, with the total value reaching ₹23.5 trillion. This surge is primarily driven by the widespread use of UPI, IMPS, FASTag, and Aadhaar-enabled Payment System (AePS).
