1. India's First Constitution Museum

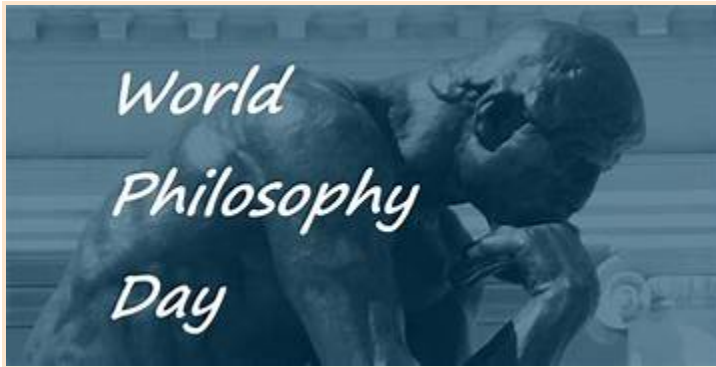
7. SEBI Abolishes 1% Security Deposit Mandate for Public Issues
