1. **India's New Consulate in Brisbane Inaugurated by EAM Jaishankar**



India's External Affairs Minister, S. Jaishankar, inaugurated the new consulate in Brisbane on November 4, 2024. This event marks a significant step in enhancing India-Australia relations, especially with recent agreements facilitating trade and strategic cooperation.

2. **Kemi Badenoch Becomes UK Conservative Party Leader**



On November 2, 2024, Kemi Badenoch made history by becoming the first Black woman to lead the UK's Conservative Party. She won the leadership race, succeeding Rishi Sunak after his resignation.
