1. India's First Vertical Lift Rail Bridge: The New Pamban Bridge





- India's first vertical lift railway sea bridge, the New Pamban Bridge, has replaced the 105-year-old Pamban Bridge. This new bridge enhances connectivity between the Indian mainland and Rameswaram in Tamil Nadu. It is designed to ensure modern train compatibility, speed, and safety, marking a significant advancement in railway infrastructure.


