1. Anna Chakra Launched



Union Minister Pralhad Joshi introduced "Anna Chakra," a tool designed to modernize the Public Distribution System (PDS) by optimizing logistics and ensuring smooth movement of food grains nationwide. Additionally, the SCAN portal was launched to automate subsidy claim processes, enhancing transparency and efficiency.

2. PM Modi Meets Bhutan's King



Prime Minister Narendra Modi hosted Bhutan's King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck and Queen Jetsun Pema Wangchuck in New Delhi, highlighting India-Bhutan's enduring partnership. 3. ISRO's PSLV-C59 Launch

6. North Korea-Russia Treaty

7. eMaap Portal for Fair Trade



The Indian government introduced the eMaap Portal to improve compliance with legal metrology standards. It simplifies regulatory processes, supports business registrations, and educates consumers about their rights, ensuring a balanced marketplace.

8. India Wins 5th Junior Hockey Asia Cup
