#### 1. Magnus Carlsen Leaves Tournament:



 The world number one chess player, Magnus Carlsen, has left a major chess tournament due to a dress code dispute. His decision has become a topic of discussion in the chess world.

#### 2. Third Eye Asian Film Festival:



The **21st edition** of the **Third Eye Asian Film Festival** will be held from **January 10 to 16, 2025** in **Mumbai and Thane**. A total of **61 films** will be showcased at the MovieMax theaters in Andheri, Sion, and Thane.

#### 3. Haryana Government Increases Ex-Gratia Amount:




 The Haryana government has increased the ex-gratia amount for the families of armed forces and Central Armed Police Forces personnel from ₹50 lakh to ₹1 crore.

### 5. ISRO's 'SpaDeX Mission':



The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will launch the 'SpaDeX Mission' on December 30, 2024. Under this mission, two small satellites will be launched for space docking from the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) at Sriharikota.

#### 6. Indian Army's 'Exercise Surya Kiran':



 A team of the Indian Army left for Nepal on December 29, 2024, to participate in the 18th Battalion-level Joint Military Exercise 'Exercise Surya Kiran'. The exercise will be held from December 31, 2024, to January 13, 2025, in Saljhandi, Nepal.

# 7. Uttarakhand Olympic Association's Trial Event:



 The Uttarakhand Olympic Association has decided to organize open trials for Handball and Volleyball at the Manoj Sarkar Sports Stadium, Rudrapur on January 1, 2025. These trials are for players who could not participate in the state games.

# 8. New Voters in Uttarakhand:



Uttarakhand will include 1,23,250 new voters in the voter list by January 2025.
According to the office of the Chief Electoral Officer, the final voter list will be published on January 6, 2025.

# 9. RBI Approves UPI Access for PPI:



 The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted permission to access the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) for Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPI) through third-party applications. This will provide more convenience to holders of prepaid products such as gift cards, metro rail cards, and digital wallets.

# 10. US Embassy Sets New Record:



• The **US Embassy in India** and its consulates have set a new record by issuing more than **10 lakh non-immigrant visas** for the second consecutive year.
