National News

1. SECL Introduces Post-Retirement Benefit Cell

2. Venezuela's Maduro Sworn in Amid Electoral Controversy



Nicolas Maduro was sworn in for a third term as Venezuela's President despite allegations of electoral fraud by his opponent, Edmundo Gonzalez. This development sparked protests and international criticism, particularly from the United States.

3. 6.9 Magnitude Earthquake Hits Japan, Tsunami Advisory Issued

8. India's Retail Inflation Drops to 5.22%
