1. 116th Mann Ki Baat:

2. China's CR450 Train:



China unveiled its world's fastest high-speed train prototype, the CR450, which reached speeds of up to 450 km/h, surpassing the CR400 Fuxing trains. 5. RBI GDP Growth Forecast:

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) projected a 6.6% GDP growth for FY25, citing factors like rural consumption recovery, government spending, and robust services exports. However, the GDP growth rate moderated to 6.0% in the first half (H1) of FY25, down from 8.2% in the same period last year, indicating some economic challenges.



6. RBI's NEFT/RTGS Name Lookup Feature:



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) introduced a name lookup feature for the NEFT and RTGS systems, aimed at reducing errors and fraud during electronic fund transfers. The feature, set to be implemented by April 2025, will allow users to verify the beneficiary's name before making transactions, similar to existing facilities in UPI and IMPS.


7. DBS Bank India CEO Appointment:
