1. India's Rural and Urban Poverty Declines



A recent report by SBI revealed a steep decline in India's rural poverty, dropping from 25.7% in 2011-12 to 4.86% in 2023-24. Urban poverty also fell to 4.09%. The reduction is largely attributed to Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT), which ensured financial aid reached the most vulnerable sections efficiently, enhancing economic inclusion and poverty alleviation.

2. Foundation of Central Ayurveda Research Institute



Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for the Central Ayurveda Research Institute in New Delhi. This state-of-the-art facility aims to promote the integration of traditional Ayurveda with modern healthcare, fostering research, education, and innovation in alternative medicine for holistic well-being.

3. CSIR's Breakthrough in Paracetamol Production

4. NIA Arrests Key Accused in PFI Funding Case

5. India and Bangladesh Exchange Fishermen
