## National News

### 1. Jan Samarth Portal completes four years

The **Jan Samarth Portal**, India's first unified digital platform for credit-linked government schemes, completed **four years on 6 June 2026**. As on 1 June 2026 it has processed about **54.10 lakh applications worth Rs 3,00,951 crore**, with approvals to **49.55 lakh beneficiaries (Rs 2,76,493 crore)**. It covers **16 credit-linked central schemes**, is available in **8 languages**, operates 24x7 and connects **269 lending institutions**.

### 2. India's Biodiversity Report 2026 and first Nagoya Protocol national report

India released **India's Biodiversity Report 2026** (insights from the **7th National Report to the CBD**) along with its **first National Report on the Nagoya Protocol** on access and benefit-sharing of genetic resources.

### 3. Cabinet's Rs 9,585-crore clean mobility scheme for Delhi-NCR

The Union Cabinet approved a two-year scheme through the **NCRPB** to replace old **BS-IV (or earlier) trucks and buses** in Delhi-NCR with **BS-VI or electric vehicles**. Outlay: **Rs 9,585 crore** (Rs 5,041 crore central support + about Rs 1,601 crore state tax concessions). Implementing ministries: **MoRTH and MoPNG**; states: Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh.

## International News

### 1. Peru votes in presidential election today

Peruvians vote on **Sunday, 7 June 2026** to elect a new president, with a tight race expected between hard-right candidate **Keiko Fujimori** and leftist **Roberto Sanchez**.

### 2. West Asia conflict: Strait of Hormuz traffic at a standstill

The **Iran-Israel conflict** has brought ship traffic through the **Strait of Hormuz** to a virtual standstill, forcing alternative routes for oil, fertiliser and goods. Lebanon's President **Joseph Aoun** condemned an Israeli strike on Lebanese territory as a violation of sovereignty; Pakistan urged an end to the war.

### 3. Pope Leo XIV: Iran war is not a 'just war'

**Pope Leo XIV**, during his six-day visit to **Spain**, said the war in Iran does not qualify as a 'just war' under Catholic teaching.

### 4. Ukraine strikes Russian refineries

Ukraine launched drone attacks on **Russian refineries and military sites**, including near **St. Petersburg**, during the final day of an international economic forum there.

## News related to Indian Banking and Finance

### 1. RBI MPC keeps repo rate unchanged at 5.25%

The RBI's **MPC (3-5 June 2026)** kept the **repo rate unchanged at 5.25%** with a **neutral stance**, prioritising growth amid imported, supply-driven inflation. The RBI also **cut its FY2026-27 GDP growth projection** from the earlier 6.9% estimate.

### 2. RBI eases norms for small NBFCs

Final guidelines allow NBFCs with **assets below Rs 1,000 crore**, no public funds and no customer interface to be classified as **'Unregistered Type I NBFCs'**, exempt from registration. Deregistration window open till **31 December 2026**.

## News related to International Banking and Finance

### 1. IMF trims global growth forecast to 3.1%

The IMF downgraded 2026 global growth to 3.1% (from 3.3%), with headline inflation rising to 4.4% due to the West Asia conflict and the spike in oil, gas, fertiliser, aluminium and helium prices after the Strait of Hormuz disruption.

### 2. Global public debt nearing 100% of GDP

The IMF projects global public debt to approach 100% of world GDP by 2028, and its Global Financial Stability Report flags elevated financial-stability risks and possible further tightening of financial conditions.

## International Sports Events

### 1. Mirra Andreeva wins French Open 2026 women's title

Nineteen-year-old Mirra Andreeva beat Poland's Maja Chwalinska 6-3, 6-3 in the Roland-Garros 2026 women's singles final (6 June) for her first Grand Slam title - the youngest champion there since Iga Swiatek (2020). The men's final is on 7 June 2026.

### 2. India vs Afghanistan one-off Test underway

India are playing a one-off Test vs Afghanistan at New Chandigarh (6-10 June 2026). 2026 also features the Men's T20 World Cup (India & Sri Lanka), Commonwealth Games (Glasgow) and Asian Games (Aichi-Nagoya, Japan).

## Major National or International Appointments

### 1. Rohit Jain appointed RBI Deputy Governor

RBI Executive Director Rohit Jain has been appointed Deputy Governor of the RBI for a three-year term; he has spent about three decades at the central bank, including in banking supervision.

### 2. Priyank Bharti named CEO of Online Gaming Authority

Priyank Bharti appointed CEO of the Online Gaming Authority of India; the UIDAI CEO received additional charge as CEO of the India AI Mission.

### 3. Prakash Rajpurohit joins MIDHANI board

IAS officer Prakash Rajpurohit appointed Government Nominee Director on the board of defence PSU MIDHANI w.e.f. 5 June 2026.

## Resignation or Dismissal

### 1. RBI cancels banking licence of Paytm Payments Bank

The RBI cancelled the banking licence of Paytm Payments Bank Limited with immediate effect - the most significant regulatory removal of a payments bank from the Indian banking system to date.

## Major Inventions and Discoveries

### 1. JWST detects methane on interstellar comet 3I/ATLAS

NASA's James Webb Space Telescope found unusual chemistry in interstellar comet 3I/ATLAS, including the first direct detection of methane on a visitor from another star system.

### 2. AI-designed universal coronavirus vaccine clears first human test

Scientists successfully tested an AI-designed universal coronavirus vaccine in humans for the first time; it was found safe and well tolerated.

### 3. Single-chip photonic processor demonstrated

Researchers created a **photonic chip that generates, steers and reads light-based information in one device** - a step toward ultra-fast, energy-efficient computing.

#### **4. Gaganyaan-1 uncrewed mission slated for H2 2026**

ISRO's Gaganyaan-1 uncrewed flight carrying half-humanoid robot **Vyommitra** is slated for **H2 2026**; over 8,000 ground tests complete, Vyommitra integration began 28 April 2026. Crewed flight (H1) targeted for 2027.
